





Therefore they are severally in mercy as appears over their names.
3	alehouse-keepers in mercy 5d	Likewise they present that William Broke, <sup>1d</sup> Johanna Goldewyer, <sup>2d</sup> and Cristina Leycettour, <sup>2d</sup> are common alehouse-keepers [pandoxatr'] and break the assize excessively. Therefore they are severally in mercy as appears etc.
