

*Indulgence granted by Cardinal John Kemp, Archbishop of Canterbury*

Dicesimo die mensie Januarii Anno Domini Mcccc quadraginta et uno quinq[ue]agesimo anno regni Henrici VIII d[omi]ni Lambethi Rimanant indulgentia concessa. Omnibus a singulis visitantibus etiam post mortem de Morden Wyntone die in festo Sancti Laurentii martyris singulis d[omi]nis vel aliud ad reparationem dictae ecclesie conferent perpetua misericordia.

The twentieth day of the month of January in the year of the Lord one thousand four hundred and fifty-three [20 January 1453/4] at Lambeth: issued: an indulgence granted to each and every person who visits the parish church of Morden in the diocese of Winchester on the feast of St Laurence the Martyr in any year, or who contributes something to the repair of the said church: to endure in perpetuity.
